



9. Natural Resource Inventory update – No additional information was provided
10. Sarah Norton provided an update on an educational pamphlet she is developing on wildlife in the Town of Marshfield, and she sought the advice and input of Commission members. Several concepts for organizing the pamphlet were discussed including protecting space in Marshfield for large mammals and describing how people interact can with their land in ways favorable to wildlife. The timing of completion of the pamphlet was discussed.

The members decided to take up the pamphlet in November with a smaller group including Anne and Bob; Rachel also will be asked.

11. Other business

- a. Annie led discussion clarifying the area to be mowed near the Covered Bridge
- b. There was a question on whether new ditching in the vicinity of the Thompson Road will be monitored. It was suggested that Rich Phillips be contacted. There is a rare, ephemeral moss species in an alder swamp adjacent to the road, and there were concerns that the ditching could affect the hydrology/drainage of the swamp, potentially affecting the moss species.
