**Review minutes from 9/3/20**

The minutes were approved as drafted.

### **Criteria for Speed Sign Placement**

Todd explained the criteria for speed signs. Speed limits need to be posted at every point of change and entry into Marshfield's jurisdictional boundary (MUTCD Section 2B.13.03 and 05). This will make it more enforceable and hold up when contested in court. Jurisdiction boundaries include municipal boundaries and whenever a town road intersects a state road (Route 2 and Route 232). In addition, speed signs should be placed where found to be useful to assist with enforcement.

Todd suggested to first check with the road crew to see if they have a sign inventory. Rich will check with them. Then volunteers could survey roads and determine if additional signage is needed. The road crew can then order and install the signs. Signs would need to be installed before the ground freezes.

### **Study of Speed Signs**

The following volunteers said they would survey the roads listed once we have information from the road crew:

- Maple Hill Road: Lorraine
- Hollister Hill Road: Lorraine
